

All guests must be 13 years or older and complete a signed waiver release before they will be allowed to participate. Guests under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian complete a signed waiver for them.

## CLOTHING

- Closed-toe shoes are **REQUIRED** to participate. Shoes that pose a possible safety risk, (high heels, sandals, etc.) are **NOT** allowed.
- Loose clothing and accessories can create unsafe conditions by limiting mobility or snagging on objects. Please be advised that you may be asked to remove items or accessories that could present a safety risk.

## **THROWING**

- One Axe, One Target. Only throw one axe at a time. This also applies to other throwable items such as throwing stars or cards.
- Guests are **NOT** allowed to bring in their own axes or throwing items. Only items provided by **HATCHET ALLEY** are allowed.
- Only **ONE** guest is allowed in the throwing area at any time. Do **NOT** throw until you have ensured the area is clear of others.
- All throws should be forward-facing, overhead, and towards the target. **NO** underhand throwing or trick shots are allowed.
- Before taking your turn, make sure you are the person "throwing" as shown on the screen, and that you are in the correct lane.
- After making your throw, move forward to retrieve your axe. If the axe remains stuck in the wood, do not attempt another throw until it is safely removed. Contact an Axepert on duty for help.
- Do **NOT** hand axes to the next thrower after you are finished throwing. After retrieving your axe, please return it to the hook.
- Keep hands OFF of the lane dividers. Do NOT enter into adjacent lanes or other lanes that you have not been assigned to.
- Follow **ALL INSTRUCTIONS** provided by the Axepert on duty at all times.

## **BEHAVIOR**

- All guests are expected to behave in a safe and responsible manner. Any guests acting in a manner that is considered unsafe will be issued a warning. Repeated warnings may result in removal from the throwing area and/or the center.
- Food and beverages are not allowed in the throwing area. All food and beverages should remain at your table.
- All guests are expected to arrive free from the influence of any substances, including alcohol. While in the center, we do ask all guests to drink responsibly for the safety of themselves and other guests. Arrival under the influence or excessive consumption during your visit will result in the removal from the throwing area and/or the center.
- Please report ANY unsafe conditions to a team member immediately.

## HEALTH WARNING

Anyone with the following physical or mental conditions should excercise caution when participating:

- Guests who may be pregnant Guests with back, shoulder, or neck ailments Guests suffering from heart-related issues
- Any other physical or mental condition that might be affected by playing or might prevent you from throwing safely

Any rules or safety violations may result in immediate removal from Hatchet Alley and/or Spare Time Texas.
